- 1. Call to Order: 3:10pm by Kurt M. in Mark's absence.
- 2. Introduction of Guests: Robert Hollenbaugh (IVC, SBS)
- 3. Adoption of Agenda
  - 1. Motion to adopt current agenda by Blake S. and seconded by Tony L. Friendly amendment to delete item 14 accepted by motioner. Motion, as amended, passed unanimously.
- 4. Approval of Minutes

- Correction to spelling of Margot Lovett; minor wording change to 6.1; and item 8 noted as tabled item.
- 2. Motion to approve March 2017 Meeting Minutes. Blake S. motioned to approve and David S. seconded the motion. Meeting Minutes as corrected passed unanimously.
- 5. Part-Time Committee Report Susan Bliss (5 minutes)
  - 1. Susan B. gave the report in Beth's absence.
  - 2. Flyer for unemployment workshop on May 5, 2017 was discussed.
  - 3. Division reps were encouraged to invite their part-timers, especially new PT faculty.
- 6. Communications Committee Report Tabled
- 7. Membership Report Blake Stephens (10 minutes)
  - 1. Fulltime enrollments are up but part-time enrollments are down.
  - 2. Blake is working on outreach to everyone but targeting part-time faculty.
  - 3. Everyone encouraged to stress the benefits of union membership to the non-members within their divisions.
- 8. Treasurer's Report Frank Gonzalez (10 minutes)
  - 1. Current budget was discussed. No significant items.
- 9. Organizing Committee Report Kurt Meyer (5 minutes)
  - 1. Nothing to report. Negotiations set to begin in the fall semester.
- 10. Negotiations Report Lewis Long (5 minutes)
  - 1. Town hall meeting held during flex week and suggestions were made by faculty in attendance.
  - 2. An email was sent out two weeks ago to all faculty asking for additional suggestions. The deadline has now passed.
  - 3. The negotiating team will meet sometime in the next two weeks to go over all the suggestions collected in order to create a survey that will be used to produce the sunshine proposal.
  - 4. We should then sunshine at the beginning of the fall semester.
  - 5. Negotiations will then probably start in December or January.
- 11. AR 5626 Discussion Independent Study
  - 1. There is nothing currently in the draft AR that allows compensation for faculty.
  - 2. Claire C. stated that the AR also needs to distinguish between independent study courses that are for curriculum-approved courses and independent study courses that are special projects. There is a form used at the colleges that distinguishes the two types of courses.
  - 3. Lewis L. pointed out that Article XV, section 3.D.7., of the contract discusses directed independent study classes and allows for 8 hours of compensated meeting time.
  - 4. Agreement to send back to Exec for clarification and further action.
- 12. Online Education Plan at Saddleback College Discussion
  - 1. Claire C. pointed out that the only concern from the FA perspective is D.3.4. regarding accessibility and evaluation. There can be a process for ensuring that online courses are accessible but it should not be part of the faculty evaluation.

- 2. Jan D. raised the issue of cap for online classes the need to perhaps negotiation for a lower cap.

  - 1. First-level interviews being conducted this week.
  - 2. Mark B. will report on further developments at the next meeting.
