Mark Blethen Receives SOCCCD W.H.O. Award

The South Orange Community College District Faculty Association has nominated our current and outgoing president, Mark Blethen, to receive the W.H.O award this year. Mark is a fierce and tireless advocate for faculty rights within our district. Under his leadership, we have made significant strides, including the negotiation of a fair compensation package for all faculty converting from Blackboard to Canvas. Mark served as a member of our last negotiating team, during which we were able to gain significant increases for our part-time faculty, including pay for office hours, and a 12% overall raise for all faculty. As president, he has been overseeing our current negotiations, during which part-time rehire rights and a greater move towards parity is at the top of our priority list. His analytical mind and ability to quickly grasp convoluted issues related to numerical data have been indispensable in the most recent and current negotiations. Mark is unflagging in his support of faculty and has a reputation among the administration for being both tenacious and persuasive. On the flip side, Mark also has considerable skills in diffusing potentially contentious situations and in facilitating the building of consensus between and among different constituent groups. He has the ability to immediately go to the root of a complex problem, whether it be a contractual, procedural or personality problem, grasp the basic issues, consider the relevant legal and contractual considerations, come up with a

simple and rational answer, and persuade others to accept it, always with humor and his own style of rough grace. He is confident and self-assured, yet also deeply respects the abilities and opinions of those with whom he works. He is truly worthy of this honor!

Farewell Remarks from our Outgoing FA President

This month marks the end of my two-year term as your SOCCCDFA president. It has certainly been a privilege and an honor serving all my colleagues at Irvine Valley College and Saddleback College. Thanks to the hard work and dedication of the Faculty Association's Representatives and officers, we have been able to secure a number of significant achievements during that time.

Initially, we successfully persuaded the District to offer, and then negotiated improvements to, an early retirement incentive program, officially known as the SRP. This program allowed 21 senior faculty to retire with a generous financial boost. While we had to say goodbye to many dear friends and colleagues who had served our colleges so well over the years, their departures have opened up opportunities for our part time colleagues to secure full time employment. This coming fall will see the beginning of those replacement positions being filled with new faculty who will undoubtedly bring new energy, knowledge, and skills to our campuses.

We have continued to fight for the rights of our part-time faculty to be treated equitably for the valuable contributions they provide to our students. Admittedly, we still have a long way to go. However, we were successful in working with the administration to end the practice of overloading our part-time faculty without fairly compensating them as full timers would be. This change in practice should, over time, create a greater demand for the creation of additional tenure track faculty positions throughout the district.

Possibly our most visible achievement was the successful fight for the adoption of the Canvas Conversion Compensation program. Most faculty will ultimately benefit financially for the hours of hard work that they will invest to change from Blackboard to Canvas. Additionally, our students will benefit from having one consistent LMS being utilized in all of their courses. A special thank you to all those faculty members who showed up at board meetings to voice their support for this program. Your voices were heard, and we would not have succeeded without your support.

Finally, I would like to personally thank my fellow association officers (Kurt Meyer, Parisa Soltani, Frank Gonzalez, Claire Cesareo, Blake Stephens, Beth Clary, Lewis Long, Margot Lovett, Kathy Schmeidler, June McLaughlin) and all the School/Division Reps who served alongside me, and by doing so made this an incredible experience of which I will always be proud.

Together, we can continue to accomplish great things for our association, and I am confident that we will.
